The Organizing and Program Committees invite you to take part in the XXVI Russian Particle Accelerator Conference RuPAC-2018.

### Goal

Goal of the event is to facilitate information interchange and discussion of various aspects of accelerator science and technology, beam physics, new accelerator development, upgrade of existing facilities, and use of accelerators for basic and applied research.

#### **Dates**

The Conference will be held in the period of Monday, October 1 – Friday, October 5, 2018.

### Location

The Conference will take place in the Institute for High Energy Physics of the National Research Centre "Kurchatov Institute" (NRC KI – IHEP) located in Protvino, Moscow region, some 120 km southward of Moscow. The expected attendance is around 150 persons. The participants will be accommodated in the local hotel PROTVA.

### **Conference schedule**

The Conference timetable foresees invited review reports (30 + 5 min), oral presentations (20 + 5 min), and poster  $(140 \times 70 \text{ cm}^2)$  sessions. The official languages are Russian and English. There will be no simultaneous translation in either direction. Texts of posters and slides should be typed in English, while oral talks by the domestic participants will be, basically, reported in Russian.

To be included into the Conference Program, abstracts in English (1500 characters. plain ASCII text) must be submitted before **July 16, 2018**, inclusively, via the JACoW web-site

Submitting your abstract this way constitutes the obligatory pre-condition for all the papers (invited, oral and poster) to be considered for including into the Conference Program.

The authors will be informed via e-mail on the decision of the Program Committee on admittance and form of presentation of their reports by **August 27, 2018.**

The Conference Proceedings (in English) will be published in the Joint Accelerator Conference Website (JACOW) <a href="http://accelconf.web.cern.ch/accelconf/">http://accelconf.web.cern.ch/accelconf/</a>. Paper submitting should follow a two-step procedure:

when the paper uploading will be opened (on August 27, 2018, expected) but not later than September 28, 2018.

2. Admitted reports (1 (backup) electron version + 1 paper hard copy) should be handed to the Organizing Committee on the first day of the Conference.

The reports of the authors from the Russian Federation have to comply with the existing rules for authorization of the information exchange.

Electron versions should meet the JACOW requirements (refer to <a href="http://accelconf.web.cern.ch/accelconf/">http://accelconf.web.cern.ch/accelconf/</a> for details on the recommendations to authors.

No papers would be accepted "for publication only". Papers presented as the "unmanned posters" would not be accepted for publication in the Proceedings as well

All the would-be attendees, both authors and listeners, will be asked to pass the registration by-procedure by filling and sending via e-mail to <a href="mailto:rupac2018@ihep.ru">rupac2018@ihep.ru</a> the relevant text forms (in preparation, to be made available since after July 1, 2018).

This registration will be opened till August 31, 2018 (for foreign participants applying for visas), or September 15, 2018 (for participants from the Russian Federation and the FSU countries) so as to provide the specific visa, travel and hotel reservation data (beyond the scientific scope) to the local Organizing Committee.
